

REVISED NOTICE

(11/10/20)

Beginning today's date, Wednesday, November 11th, 2020, First Baptist Church will implement instructional procedures specified in newly revised Iowa proclamation by Governor Kim Reynolds regarding the state of the public health disaster emergency. **(For further details concerning current COVID-19 rules for gatherings, see State of Iowa, Executive Department, Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, located on homepage.)**

Procedural Adjustments:

1. Social distancing of at least 6 feet between groups while indoors will be maintained at all times.
2. Groups will be limited to 8 persons unless members of the same family group.
3. Hand sanitizer provided at the front entrance of the building and in the bathroom.
4. **(New)** According to proclamation, all persons older than 2 years MUST wear masks indoors when gathering is larger than 25. Masks are encouraged for the safety of others, except for underlying health conditions, (e.g., asthma, etc.) **Disposable masks provided at front entrance.**
5. **(New)** Breakfast and fellowship hour are discontinued until the proclamation expires or new instructional procedures are mandated.
6. **(New)** Adult Sunday School class will continue to meet at the regularly-scheduled time and place; however, the Youth Sunday School class will be held in a separate location (for the protection of the elderly in our congregation).
7. **(New)** Lastly, these procedures will remain in effect until the expiration date of the governor's proclamation, December 10th, 2020.
